The Circle's unique formula introduces teenage volunteers to the children and their families, and through the shared experiences, all are enriched.

- The child with special needs looks forward to a weekly visit and the opportunity to play with and learn from their older friends.
- The teenage volunteer learns the value of giving, and cherishes the experience of making a difference in a child's life and bringing a smile to his or her face.
- The child's family gets a needed respite and the pleasure of seeing their child become a part of the community circle.

The Friendship Circle is made up of five parts: volunteers, children, parents, staff, and supporters. The true beauty of the Circle is how we all link together to form a seamless circle of friendship.

The Friendship Circle of Nassau County is a joint project of the Chabad Houses of West Hempstead and Mineola.

Yad Tamar

Yad Tamar is a dedicated group of volunteers, mothers of soldiers and former soldiers, working tirelessly since October 7th to support our reserve soldiers. We provide essential protective gear, including helmets, bulletproof vests, and protective glasses. With no overhead costs, 100% of donations go directly to purchasing gear. We verify every request for legitimacy and only fulfill those from company officers. We personally deliver the gear to the front lines and redistribute it after reserve duty. As new units are deployed to Gaza, the need remains urgent. Every donation, big or small, makes a significant impact.

Bulletproof vests: 1100 shekel/\$350

Medic vest: 1500 shekel/\$430

Tactical belt (for soldiers carrying over 50 % of their body weight) 450 shekel/\$130

Protective glasses: 250 shekel/\$70

Through Friendship Circle the alienation of disabled children who are educated separately is turned around in West Hempstead. This is a service to the ENTIRE community. Teens have exposure to differences in the context of friendship and children educated outside of the mainstream can come to shul and community and find at least one friend in the crowd who waves hello and is there for them on Chanukah, Purim and their birthday. This also means parents of disabled kids can find babysitters who don't see their children as foreign. It also means that the volunteers expand their bandwidth to relate socially with people who have different relating styles. When they enter the workplace and become parents themselves this often becomes a subtle building block of their success.
